NAHEMI MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

The NAHEMI Executive Committee works with the following criteria when assessing new applicants for membership of the Association:

- 1. A course should have dedicated equipment, facilities and staff and be at a Further Education, Undergraduate or Post Graduate level (as opposed to equipment etc. being borrowed to facilitate courses, or modules, that involve 'media' practice).**
- 2. Ideally, a course should offer a minimum of 50% practical filmmaking. It is recognised that most NAHEMI members operate with a practice/theory ratio of between 60/40 and frequently as high as 80/20.**
- 3. An applicant's course should focus on the subjects of Film, Video, Television and Animation (emphasising the moving image) as opposed to 'all' media subjects.**
- 4. Courses should be actively involved with the exhibition and distribution of their students work, and that the work must aspire to a high quality and to have cultural value.**
- 5. Courses should have a serious concern to balance vocational outcomes with personal educational development.**

The NAHEMI Executive Committee will use the published curriculum of a course or programme as evidence of suitability for membership.

The decision to accept or reject an application is made at the discretion of the NAHEMI Executive Committee (the membership of which is published on the NAHEMI website).
